BACKLIT TREESCAPES IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 31 January – Friday 1 February 2019

2-day Wednesday 30 – Thursday 31 October 2019

How to approach painting backlit trees creating strong contrasting lights and darks using rollers, mark making with card and large brushes.

BEACHES, PEBBLES & ROCKS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 21 – Friday 22 March 2019

We will be concentrating how to paint beaches, create pebbles and rocks using various expressive mark making techniques leaving out minute detail but including just enough!



BREAKING WAVES & SEASCAPES IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 22 – Friday 23 August 2019

Loose, exciting and painterly seascapes using acrylics, inks and drawing in with oil pastels, creating textures with loose washes and glazes.

EXCITING ADVENTURES IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 23 - Thursday 24 January 2019

2-day Thursday 3 – Friday 4 October 2019

Ideal if you're a beginner or indeed if you're fairly experienced, we will experiment with lots of techniques for a fairly relaxed but well structured 2-days! From playing with paint and mark making, we will then plan to complete a considered painting based on a subject you choose using one or more of the techniques learned.

EXPERIMENTS IN MIXED MEDIA

3-day Tuesday 12 – Thursday 14 February 2019

3-day Tuesday 3 – Thursday 5 December 2019

Three fun packed days including multiple warm-up exercises using Watercolour, Ink & Pastel; Paper & Paint (acrylics); Water Media & Texture. Let your creative process go wild with this 3-day workshop.



NEW INTERESTING FOREGROUNDS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 3 – Thursday 4 April 2019

2-day Thurs 28 – Fri 29 November 2019

Very often tangled brambles, a busy hedgerow or a complicated foreground generally, can deter you from picking up your paintbrush! This workshop concentrates on turning such subject matter into an interesting foreground, almost making it the focal point with lots of interest. Create movement and energy in a painting by incorporating texture with a semi-abstract approach.



KEEPING A SKETCHBOOK

2-day Tuesday 17 - Wednesday 18 June 2019 Cost: £140

3-day Wednesday 24 – Friday 26 July 2019 Cost: £210

This workshop will focus on the unique challenges of plein air painting. The ability to see and simplify, to organise the subject matter, and to present it in a simple and straightforward manner. The workshop will include demonstrations as well as individual attention. You will need to be fairly active and mobile. Painting plein air in watercolour + ink/pastel - gathering source material in the form of sketches and photographs for future use, understanding the importance of painting from life.



LANDSCAPE ABSTRACTIONS

2-day Wednesday 11 – Thursday 12 December 2019

The landscape will be the framework that you will build on to move into abstraction. Some people paint abstracts entirely from their imaginations, but having something 'real' as the starting point gives a direction to start working in, to kick start your imagination. We will work on some techniques in acrylics on Day 1 and begin working on a 'design' for our finished work. Whether you are already working in landscape and want a little more edge to your work or are trying to find an approach to abstraction, this workshop should help you.

LOVE YOUR COLOURS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 16 – Thursday 17 January 2019

2-day Thursday 17 – Friday 18 October 2019

Concentrating on the use of colour first and foremost – Using a limited and expressive colour palette, exploring a range of colour combinations using a loose and free approach to create a considered painting in acrylics.



MOOD AND ATMOSPHERE IN ACRYLICS

1-day Tuesday 16 – Wednesday 17 April 2019

This workshop is about putting your interpretation on the subject by painting on a coloured ground and working in many thin layers, 'scumbling' the paint. It's an extremely exciting and satisfying way of working and suits all levels of ability from newcomers to acrylics to exhibiting artists! Ideal if you want to loosen up and be more expressive.



PAINTING LOOSE IN WATERCOLOURS

2-day Thursday 3 – Friday 4 January 2019

1-day Wednesday 17 July 2019

This workshop will encourage you to stop fiddling and loosen up your watercolour landscapes! A series of stimulating demonstrations and exercises in composition, the expressive use of colour, pigment application and dynamic ways of applying paint, all designed to encourage well-planned yet spontaneous watercolour paintings.



NEW PAINTING WITH A PALETTE KNIFE

Wednesday 22 – Thursday 23 May 2019

This is a great workshop to really express yourself, break away from painting tight and make some lively and striking mark making. Explore techniques such as thick impasto, and applying paint with a palette knife. Experimental and energising! A real opportunity to be expressive.



SKIES & REFLECTIONS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Thursday 28 – Friday 29 March 2019

2-day Thursday 14 – Friday 15 November 2019

Concentrating on the subject of painting skies, water and reflections, we will consider colour mixing and layering to create glowing and luminous results!



NEW SPRING/SUMMER MEADOWS IN ACRYLICS

2-day Wednesday 1 – Thursday 2 May 2019

2-day Wednesday 28 – Thursday 29 August 2019

Wild flowers meadows, poppies and interesting foregrounds generally – the type of subject matter we come across throughout the summer.

TREES IN THE LANDSCAPE IN WATERCOLOUR

2-day Wednesday 10 – Thursday 11 April 2019

We will be tackling trees in the landscape, analyzing shapes, colours to create distance and perspective, getting away from painting actual trees but mark making. Experimenting with watercolours with many demo's and hands-on painting.

Create movement and energy in a painting by incorporating soft pastel...making a painting 'zing', and using oil pastel as a resist to enhance textural qualities using the oiliness as a contrast to the fluidity of watercolour. 'Pen' and ink with watercolour is a quick and simple method by which detail can be suggested in a few lines. Mark making with waterproof Indian ink and/or acrylic inks with a 'pen' that is a sharpened twig, wooden peg, lollipop stick or piece of bamboo.
